The course covers the Arabic alphabet (including writing, reading, the vowels, pronunciation); basic grammatical structures and communication crucial for day to day life such as introducing yourself, getting around and visiting the shop. We will learn about Palestinian culture through the course, as well as examining local media outlets.

By the end of this course, you will be able to engage in daily conversations, listen and understand short presentations, and also read and write using the Arabic language.

The course is suitable for complete beginners as well as those who have already mastered a few words!

### WANT TO GET TO KNOW PALESTINIAN CULTURE FURTHER?

TINAU's Palestinian Society Intermediate course has been designed to help you immerse yourself in Palestianian society and culture. The classes will take place in the local Jerusalemite spoken dialect and will be topic-based. Topics will include Palestinian life in different Jerusalem neighbourhoods, theatre and other arts, customs and traditions, family and food.

The heart of this course is speaking, but there will also be reading, writing and listening work. Texts will be in Arabic script and not transliterated (if you need help with this, please let us know in advance). The course style follows a learner-centred and communication-centred approach, meaning grammatical points will be taught as they arise naturally through the interactions in the class, rather than fixed in advance. As the course is conversational-focused, you can expect to speak in more complex sentences, understand more of what's going on, and talk about broader and more abstract topics with greater confidence.

Please note, this course is for learners who can already communicate in the language about their lives and basic needs, can create sentences in the languages and can read the Arabic script.

TINAU's Advanced Arabic course will let you delve into colloquial Arabic at a higher level. Therefore, if you can already get by in most day-to-day conversations but want to deepen your language

The course is a combination of speaking practice (and reading and writing), acquiring historical, linguistic and cultural knowledge about the Arabic language in general and the Jerusalemite language specifically.

We will also touch on the position of Jerusalemite Palestinians and Israel's policies towards them, the history behind Semitic languages, as well as loan words from Arabic in Hebrew (and vice versa). Finally, we will look at how the language has developed and the social influences which shape it.

Please note, this course is for learners who have a strong grounding in Arabic and can speak, read and write about many different topics.
